



Student Exchange Programs

NEIU runs exchange programs with over 40 universities around the world. We welcome international exchange students, both those who come to take academic courses and those who come to learn English. Come for just one semester or for a whole academic year!

Intensive English Language Program

International exchange students can improve their English language skills through our Intensive English Language Program at the School of Advancement of English Learning and Language (SAELL). SAELL is based on the Common European Framework Reference for Language and is not for credit. SAELL costs only US \$3,600 per semester.

International exchange students pay tuition to their home university. NEIU only collects a few small fees for city-wide transportation and lab costs.


