

## RESOLUTION NO. 95 OF THE SCIENTIFIC COUNCIL OF THE DISCIPLINES OF POLITICAL SCIENCE AND ADMINISTRATION AND SECURITY SCIENCE

of 3 March 2022

## concerning support for the position of the Polish academic community expressed on 24 February 2022 in connection with the Russian aggression against Ukraine

Pursuant to § 49(7) of the Statute of the University of Warsaw (UW Monitor of 2019, item 190), the Scientific Council of the Disciplines of Political Science and Administration and Security Science resolves as follows:

§ 1

In the face of Russia's aggression against Ukraine, the Scientific Council of the Disciplines of Political Science and Administration and Security Science at the University of Warsaw, standing in solidarity with the Ukrainian people during this time, expresses a position consistent with that of the organisations and institutions of the Polish academic community of 24 February 2022, which is presented in § 2 of the resolution.

§ 2

"In connection with Russia's armed aggression against Ukraine and the brutal violation of international agreements and standards of international relations, the Polish academic community strongly condemns the assault on and use of violence against our neighbour. We express our full solidarity with the entire Ukrainian people and our support of Ukraine as a sovereign country and we promise all possible assistance during this difficult time. At the same time, we appeal to the authorities of the Ministry of Education and Science to initiate special measures, including legal measures, to support Ukrainian scientists and PhD and other students who wish to continue their activity at Polish universities. The Polish academic community will further intensify and develop all forms of cooperation with our Ukrainian academic partners".

The resolution shall enter into force upon its adoption.
