### IMPORTANT NOTES FOR THE STUDY PROGRAMME:

1. In the course of the programme students must earn 5 ECTS for courses (electives offered by the University - OGUN) taught in humanities.
2. Students are obliged to pass foreign language exam (it may not be English nor the official language nor national language of the country of nationality of the student) at B1 level.
3. ECTS for general electives must be proved at the end of the particular academic study year (aggregate for both terms).
4. 90 hours of Physical Exercises must be proved at the end of the course of study at the latest. \*These can be chosen from the list of courses in English offered by the Faculty of Political Science and International Studies.
