### IMPORTANT NOTES FOR THE STUDY PROGRAMME:

- **\*2** Foreign language course: The chosen language can be neither the official language nor national language of the country of nationality of the student nor English.
- **\*3** Physical education: 90 hours of Physical Exercises must be proved at the end of the course of study at the latest.
- **\*4** Elective course from the offer of the Faculty of Political Science and International Studies/Faculty of Economic Sciences: These can be chosen from the list of courses in English offered by the Faculty of Political Science and International Studies and Faculty of Economic Sciences.
- **\*5** General elective courses: In the course of the programme students must earn 5 ECTS for courses (electives offered by the University - OGUN) taught in humanities. ECTS for general electives must be proved at the end of the particular academic study year (aggregate for both terms).
- **\*6** Foreign language exam B1: The chosen language can be other than the one that the student has studied but it can be neither the official language nor national language of the country of nationality of the student nor English.
