In 2014 got his Ph.D. Currently, he is Assistant Professor and teaching the course of "Civilizations and Cultures "at ADA University (Baku, Azerbaijan). He is involved in academic research through culturological fieldwork and presentations. Dr. Jeyhun Rzayev is an author of the 2 guidelines and 25 scientific articles, co-author of the 4 books.

Dr. Nigar Akhundova is a leading researcher at the Institute of History, historian and teacher, holder of an honorary diploma from the Ministry of Education of the Republic of Azerbaijan, author of a number of studies on the development of cultural society in Soviet Azerbaijan

The lecture implies a story about the restoration of architectural monuments of Azerbaijan, museums and religious sites (churches, mosques), partially destroyed during the Soviet era, partially during the 30-year period of occupation. Many sketches and projects will be used to demonstrate how these monuments looked before, how they are being restored today and how they are planned to be created in the future.
